Objectives of the business environment reform programmes. Reduction of juridical, institutional and regulatory hurdles. Modernisation of the administrations.
- **Reform Dimensions:** Reform support levels. Functional areas and the reform programme cycle.
- **Reform Implementation Strategy:** Prerequisites. Concept development. Engagement of stakeholders (public–public and public–private dialogue). Proposal of juridical, institutional, procedural and technological solutions. Practical implementation plan.
- **Reports and International Rankings:** Doing Business, Global Competitiveness Index. Indicators used in the analysis of the economic outcomes and in the identification of the successful business regulation reform. The economies where these were adopted and the reason for their implementation.
- **Reform Implementation:** Workshop on the reform implementation in an area measured by the Doing Business report indicators of the World Bank.
